#### 1. GENERAL EXPENDITURE LIMITS

a) Type of personnel (for the purpose of expenditure limits)

<u>Personnel Type A</u>: Professors and Researchers, the Director, the Secretary General Personnel Type B: the rest of SISSA staff (including grant holders and doctoral students)

## b) Accompanying staff

Personnel sent on a professional trip, travelling with personnel of higher qualification may be authorized upon specific request of the interested party, to benefit from the same reimbursement conditions ("actual costs" only) as the personnel of higher qualification.

#### c) External staff

The reimbursement of expenses is provided within the limits foreseen for the qualification held in the administration / institution of origin.
